- (a) Write in brief about the oil industry of the Middle-East.
- (b) Give a brief account of physiography of North America.
- (c) Write a brief note on the 'cold desert' regions of the world.
- (d) Write a brief note on high population density region of Asia.
- (e) Outline the trend of growth of population of the world since 1901.
