  - (b) Write a note on the significance of the chorus in *Doctor Faustus*.
  - (c) Make an assessment of the character of Marchbanks.

- (d) Comment briefly on the theme of waiting in Waiting for Godot.
- (e) How does the subplot of Lorenzo-Jessica in the play, The Merchant of Venice support the main plot both thematically and structurally? Give a reasoned answer.
- (f) Assess briefly the character of Cliff Lewis in Look Back in Anger.

  - (a) Discuss The Merchant of Venice as a typical Shakespearean comedy.

Give a character sketch of Shylock.

(b) Critically comment on the Vladimir-Estragon relationship. What do you think they symbolize?

Or

"Beckett subtitled his play, Waiting for Godot as a tragi-comedy." How far is it appropriate to describe the play thus?

(c) Critically comment on the relationship between Jimmy and Alison in Look Back in Anger. Or.

Discuss Look Back in Anger as a play of protest against contemporary English society in post-war England.

(d) Discuss Candida as a play of ideas.

Describe the auction scene in *Candida*. How does it reveal the traits of the main characters?

(e) Sketch the character of Dr. Faustus as a typical product of the Renaissance.

Or

Discuss Doctor Faustus as an allegory.
